

The Village of Lewiston, Lewiston Council on the Arts and the Niagara River Region Chamber of Commerce have forged a partnership to create the Lewiston International Peace Garden, a beautiful and secluded courtyard situated between three of Lewiston's historic buildings: the Frontier House, the Little Yellow House, and the Big Yellow House.

The garden was initiated by the LCA and continues to be a partnership with many other community groups and volunteers. In 2010, this courtyard was dedicated as a War of 1812 Bicentennial Peace Garden and is included on a map which will highlight peace gardens for visitors on both sides of the border.

It has also been designated as an Honorary international Peace Garden, part of the Peace Garden Trail, and OPEN Garden Walk Buffalo Niagara. You can be a part of the Lewiston Peace Garden.
